Level 2 floorplan

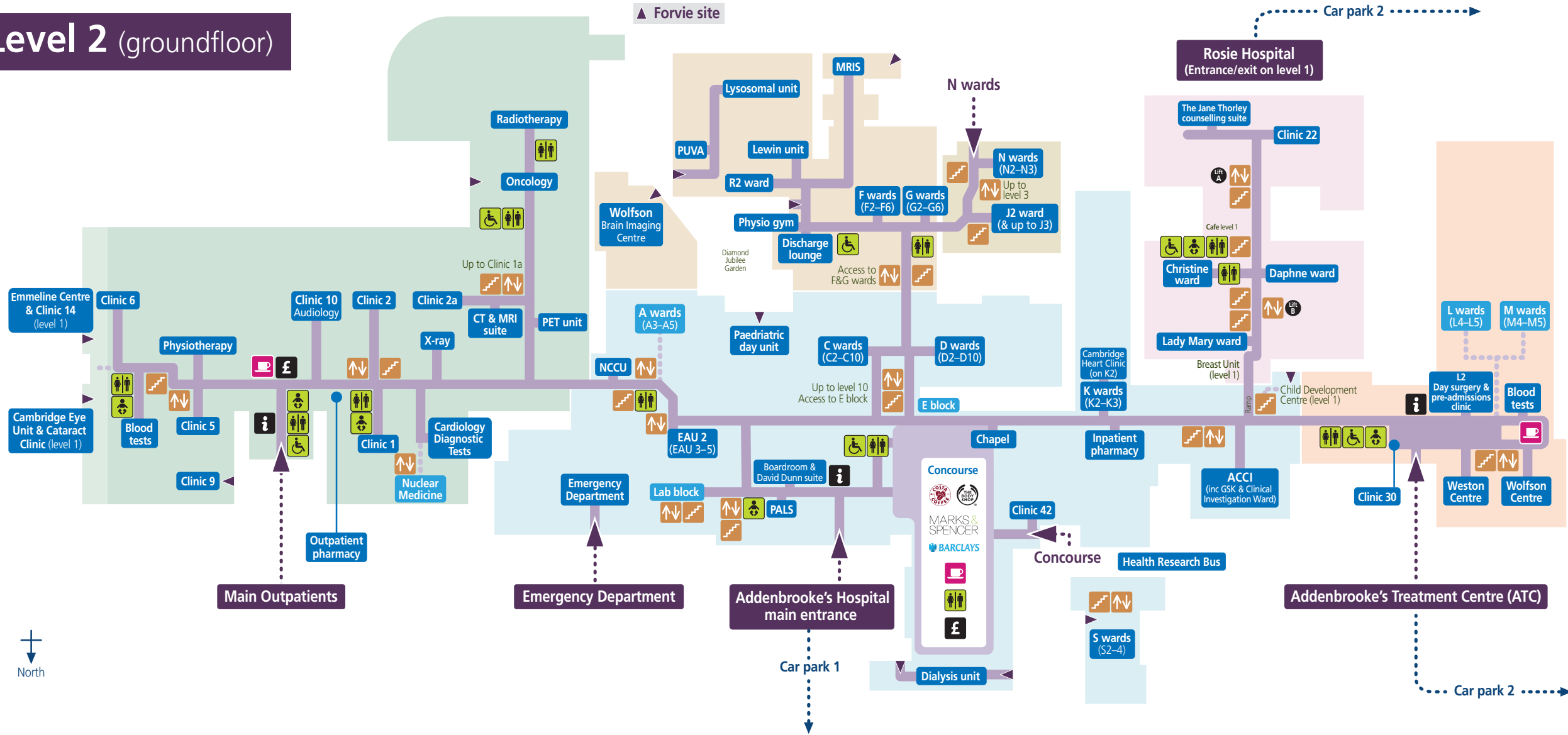
